Exemption Notice

Exemption No: ECP-26-0052E

I, David Perry, a Delegate of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the National Environmental Protection Agency (the National EPA) grant this exemption from Part 3 of the *Product Emissions Standards Act 2017* (the Act) to **Power Equipment Pty. Ltd. (ABN 97005866642)**.

This exemption is granted under Section 32 of the *Product Emissions Standards Rules 2017* (the Rules) in accordance with exemption category 30 (1)(d), use by an emergency services organisation, for the import and supply of the emissions-controlled products specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

This exemption comes into force on the date that it is published on the National EPA's website.

This exemption expires on the date specified in Condition 1 of Schedule 2.

In accordance with paragraph 32(1)(a) of the Rules, notice of this exemption will be published on the National EPA's website.

Schedule 2

Exemption Conditions

In accordance with subsection 34(2) of the Product Emissions Standards Rules 2017, the exemption for the engines specified in Schedule 1 is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. The import and supply of the emissions-controlled products (ECPs) must be completed prior to the expiry date of **31 July 2028**.
2. The ECPs must only be supplied by **Power Equipment Pty Ltd** through an authorised dealer for the ultimate use of Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) or a SLSA affiliated state or territory-based entity for rescue or emergency services purposes.
3. Upon arrival, until the ECPs are supplied, the ECPs must be securely stored on **Power Equipment Pty Ltd** premises and marked in such a manner that they are clearly identifiable as the ECPs imported under this exemption.
4. A copy of this exemption must be clearly displayed in the area(s) of the premises where the ECPs are stored.
5. The ECPs must not be displayed by any person for sale in a retail showroom or sales area accessible to the public and must not be available for purchase in Australia to the public through **Power Equipment Pty Ltd** dealer network or by any other means.
6. Exempted ECPs imported but not supplied by **31 July 2028** are not covered by this exemption.
7. **Power Equipment Pty Ltd** must submit a comprehensive report demonstrating compliance with the conditions of this exemption prior to **31 July 2028**.
8. This exemption is for a total of **400** ECPs, with the total to be made up of any combination of the ECPs as described in Schedule 1.
