**NOTICE OF APPLICATION RECEIVED UNDER THE
HAZARDOUS WASTE (REGULATION OF EXPORTS AND IMPORTS) ACT 1989**

Pursuant to section 33 of the *Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989*, notice is given that application AUH26-016 has been received from Iscrap Exports Pty Ltd (ACN 624 388 263), 10 Lisbon St, Fairfield East, NSW 2165 (Telephone: +61 431 419 695).

The application relates to the export of up to 4,000 T of lead grid and paste derived from waste lead-acid batteries (Basel code A1160). It is proposed that this waste will be exported to the Republic of Korea for recovery operation R4 – Recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds at the Korea Zinc Co., Ltd facility in Ulsan, Republic of Korea.

Written comments on the permit application may be lodged with the National Environmental Protection Agency (National EPA) within 15 business days of publication of this notice.
