**NOTICE OF DECISION TO GRANT A PERMIT UNDER THE
HAZARDOUS WASTE (REGULATION OF EXPORTS AND IMPORTS) ACT 1989**

Pursuant to section 33 of the *Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989*, notice is given that special import permit AUH26-019 was granted to Geocycle SBF Pty Limited (ACN 072 838 209), 92-94 Ordish Road, Dandenong South, VIC 3175, Australia (Telephone: +61 411 209 629).

The particulars of the permit are as follows:

- (i) The proposed recipient of the waste is Geocycle SBF Pty Limited, 92 Ordish Road, Dandenong South, VIC 3175, Australia (Telephone: +61 411 209 629).
- (ii) The type of waste is mixed pesticide waste (Basel code A4030).
- (iii) The maximum quantity of the waste that may be imported is 150 tonnes.
- (iv) The waste is to be contained during transport in 200 L closed top metal drums loaded into shipping containers.
- (v) The waste is to be transported by road to the port of export, shipped by sea, and then by road from the port of destination to the recovery facility.
- (vi) The waste may only be imported during the permit period.
- (vii) The waste is to be exported from the Port of Auckland, New Zealand – provided that the required Basel export permit is obtained prior to export – to the Port of Melbourne, Australia.
- (viii) The waste may transit or tranship Australian ports, as needed, and transit the ports of Tauranga, Wellington, Lyttleton, Bluff, Port Chalmers, Nelson, and Napier in New Zealand. No other transit ports are permitted.
- (ix) The waste is to undergo the following recovery operations in Australia:
 - a. R13 – Accumulation of material intended for any operation in Section B, Annex IV of the Basel Convention
 - b. R1 – Use as a fuel (other than in direct incineration) or other means to generate energy.
- (x) The waste is to undergo the above listed recovery operations at the following Australian facilities:
 - a. Geocycle SBF Pty Limited, Dandenong South, VIC (R13)
 - b. Cement Australia, Railton, TAS (R1).

The permit period is from the date below until the last departure date of 30 June 2027. All shipments must leave the port of export before or on the last departure date.

The permit includes and is subject to conditions.
