**NOTICE OF APPLICATION RECEIVED UNDER THE
HAZARDOUS WASTE (REGULATION OF EXPORTS AND IMPORTS) ACT 1989**

Pursuant to section 33 of the *Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989*, notice is given that application AUH26-025 has been received from TES-AMM New Zealand (NZBN 9429033787855), 44 Moffat Road, Tauranga, Bay of Plenty Region 3110, New Zealand (Telephone: +61 431 331 853).

The application relates to the transit or transshipment of up to 1,200 T of waste electrical and electronic equipment and assemblies (WEEE), including lithium-ion batteries, toner and ink cartridges, and other electronic equipment and components (Basel codes A1170, A1181 and A4070), from New Zealand to Singapore. The waste is proposed to transit or be transhipped through Australian ports, including but not limited to Adelaide, Fremantle, Melbourne, and Sydney. The waste will undergo recovery operation R4 (recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds) at the TES-AMM Singapore Pte Ltd facility and the TES B Pte Ltd facility in Singapore.

Written comments on the permit application may be lodged with the National Environmental Protection Agency (National EPA) within 15 business days of publication of this notice. Comments should be addressed to the Director, Hazardous Waste and National Television and Computer Recycling Scheme (NTCRS) Section, National Environmental Protection Agency, GPO Box 3090, CANBERRA ACT 2601, or sent by email to hazardous.waste@nationalepa.gov.au.
