Exemption Notice

Exemption No: ECP-26-0054E

I, David Perry, a Delegate of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the National Environmental Protection Agency (the National EPA) grant this exemption from Part 3 of the Product Emissions Standards Act to STIHL Pty Ltd (ABN 76 004 881 145)

This exemption is granted under Section 32 of the Product Emissions Standards Rules 2017 (the Rules) in accordance with exemption category 30 (1)(a), export, for the import of the emissions-controlled products specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

This exemption comes into force on the date that it is published on the National EPA's Website.

This exemption expires on the date specified in Condition 1 of Schedule 2.

Schedule 2

Exemption Conditions

In accordance with subsection 34(2) of the *Product Emissions Standards Rules 2017*, the exemption for the engines specified in Schedule 1 is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. The import of the ECPs must be completed prior to the expiry date of **31 August 2028**.
2. Upon arrival, the ECPs must be securely stored on STIHL Pty Ltd's premises and marked in such a manner that it is clearly identifiable as the ECP imported under this exemption.
3. A copy of this exemption must be clearly displayed in the area(s) of the premises where the ECPs are stored.
4. The ECPs must not be displayed by any person for sale in a retail showroom or sales area accessible to the public and must not be available for purchase in Australia to the public through STIHL Pty Ltd's dealer network or by any other means.
5. STIHL Pty Ltd must submit a comprehensive report demonstrating compliance with the conditions of this exemption prior to 31 July 2028.
6. This exemption is for a total of 390 ECPs, with the total to be made up of any combination of the ECPs as described in Schedule 1.
