**NOTICE OF DECISION TO GRANT A PERMIT UNDER THE
HAZARDOUS WASTE (REGULATION OF EXPORTS AND IMPORTS) ACT 1989**

Pursuant to section 33 of the *Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989*, notice is given that special export permit AUH26-016 was granted to Iscrap Exports Pty Ltd (ACN 624 388 263), 10 Lisbon St, Fairfield East, NSW 2165, Australia (Telephone: +61 431 419 695).

The particulars of the permit are as follows:

- (i) The proposed recipient of the waste is Korea Zinc Co., Ltd, 139, Ijin Ro Onsan-Eup, Ulhu-Gun, Ulsan 44997, Republic of Korea (Telephone: +82 269 472 199).
- (ii) The type of waste is lead grid and paste (Basel code A1160).
- (iii) The maximum quantity of the waste that may be exported is 4,000 tonnes.
- (iv) The waste is to be contained during transport in non-spill lined polypropylene bags loaded into 20-foot or 40-foot containers.
- (v) The waste is to be transported by road or train to the port of export, shipped by sea, and then by road or train from the port of destination to the recovery facility.
- (vi) The waste may only be exported during the permit period.
- (vii) The waste is to be exported from the Ports of Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane or Adelaide, Australia to the Port of Busan, the Republic of Korea – provided that all required Basel import permits are obtained prior to import.
- (viii) The waste may transit or tranship Australian ports, as needed. No other transit ports are permitted.
- (ix) The waste is to undergo a recovery operation at the Korea Zinc Co., Ltd facility in Onsan-eup, Ulsan, the Republic of Korea.
- (x) The waste is to undergo recovery operation R4 – Recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds.

The permit period is from the date below until the last departure date of 14 July 2027. All shipments must leave the last Australian port before or on the last departure date.

The permit includes and is subject to conditions.
