**NOTICE OF APPLICATION RECEIVED UNDER THE
HAZARDOUS WASTE (REGULATION OF EXPORTS AND IMPORTS) ACT 1989**

Pursuant to section 33 of the *Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989*, notice is given that application AUH26-014 has been received from Close the Loop Pty Ltd (ACN 095 718 317), 43-47 Cleeland Rd, Oakleigh South, VIC 3167 (Telephone: +61 1800 24 24 73).

The application relates to the import of up to 100 T of waste printer cartridges containing residual toner and/or ink (Basel code A4070) from New Zealand for recovery operations R2 (solvent reclamation/regeneration), R4 (recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds), and R5 (recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials) at the Close the Loop facility in Reservoir, Victoria.

Residual inks will undergo recovery operation R12 (accumulation intended for recovery operations) at the Geocycle SBF Pty Ltd facility in Dandenong South, Victoria, followed by operation R1 (use as a fuel – other than direct incineration – or other means to generate energy) at the Cement Australia (Queensland) Pty Ltd facility at Gladstone, Queensland.

Residual mixed plastics unsuitable for further material recovery will undergo recovery operation R12 (accumulation intended for recovery operations) at the Veolia-ResourceCo Alternative Fuels Pty Ltd facility in Wingfield, South Australia, followed by operation R1 (use as a fuel – other than direct incineration – or other means to generate energy) at the Adelaide Brighton Cement Ltd facility in Birkenhead, South Australia.

Written comments on the permit application may be lodged with the National Environmental Protection Agency (National EPA) within 15 business days of publication of this notice.
